For a Catholic to be a sponsor for the Sacraments of Baptism or Confirmation, one must be a practicing Catholic regularly attending Sunday Mass and receiving the Sacraments, a registered member of the Parish receiving contribution envelopes to support the Parish for a minimum of four months. All requests for a certificate should be made four weeks in advance of the designated date needed for sponsorship.

Young adults of parishioners who have earlier been under their parent's registration and who are now on their own and remain in the Parish must register as an adult parishioner and receive envelopes.

Pastor's Note:

"Lord, Be Merciful To Me, A Sinner"

Two contrasting characters illustrate a spiritual truth: one embodies pride, the other humility. The proud Pharisee stood prominently in the temple, praying: "O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity — greedy, dishonest, adulterous — or even like that tax collector over there." In stark contrast, the humble tax collector stood apart, unable even to lift his eyes to heaven. He beat his breast and cried out in desperation: "O God, be merciful to me, a sinner."

This parable reminds us that acknowledging our failures and shortcomings requires humility. The Pharisee sought to prove his own righteousness by diminishing others, elevating himself through comparison. Yet authentic spiritual growth demands no such collateral damage. To rise higher, we need not push others down. True goodness blossoms from nurturing our own inner light, not by extinguishing the flames burning within those around us.

Humility, therefore, is the essential recognition that we possess nothing inherently worthy of boasting about before God. It is the honest acceptance that, regardless of earthly achievements or status, we remain utterly dependent on God's mercy. Ultimately, true righteousness begins not with elevating ourselves above others, but with kneeling before God and simply saying, "Lord, be merciful to me, a sinner."
